- Adjusting machinery and repairing and/or replacing defective parts
- Reading and interpreting diagrams and schematic drawings, blueprints, and manufacturer's installation manuals to complete assigned projects
- Participating in the preventative maintenance program on all equipment for continuous improvement of all machines
- Operating machine tools to fabricate parts required during overhaul, maintenance, or set-up of machineries
- Fit bearings, align gears and shafts, attach motors, and connect couplings and belts
- Service and repair hydraulic, pneumatic, and programmable logic controls
- May do some tack welding and fabrication as well as maintain inventory of replacement parts
- · Ensuring operating safety devices function properly on completion of repairs, modifications, and installations
- Keeping detailed and accurate maintenance reports and documentation
- · Cleaning, lubricating, and performing other routine maintenance work on machineries
- May operate mobile equipment such as front-end loaders, forklifts, skid-steer loaders, man lifts and overhead cranes
- Performs area housekeeping duties and may perform work area and safety audits
